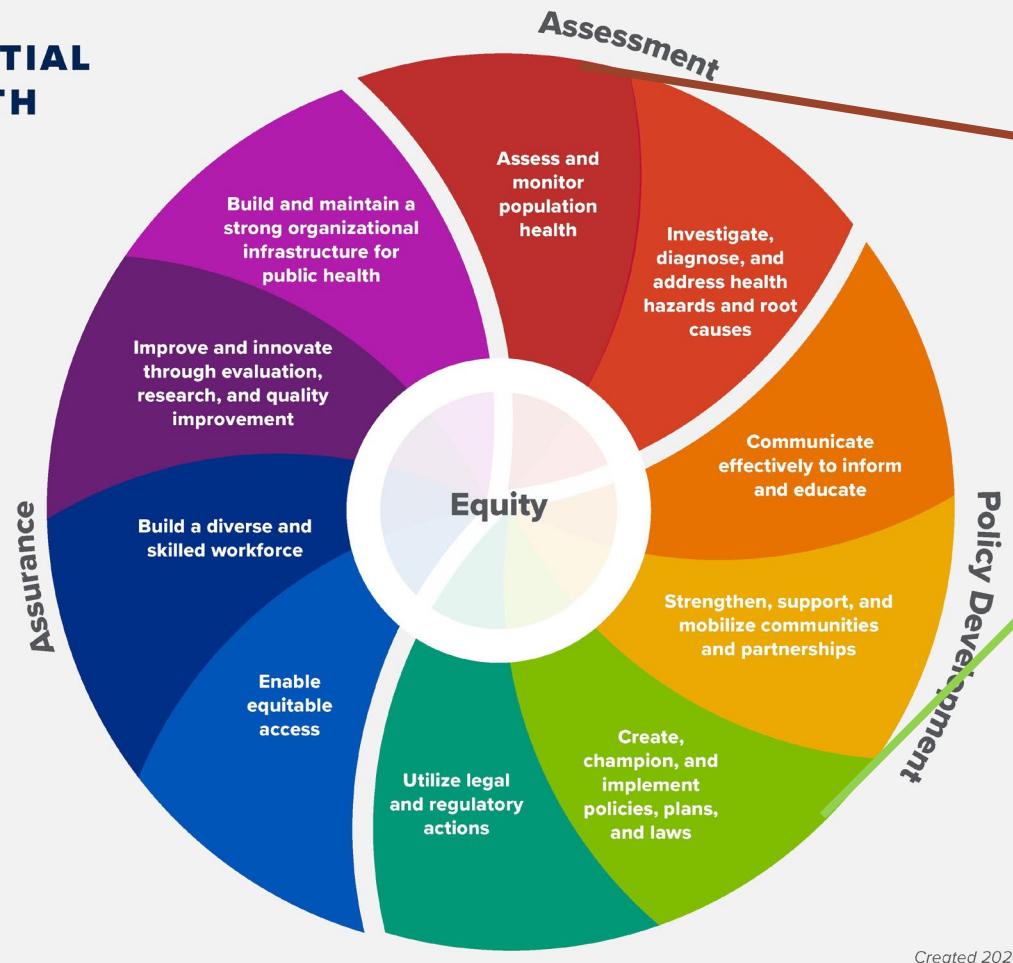
- The assurance of the conditions for optimal health for all people

# Public Health Accreditation Board (PHAB)

## THE 10 ESSENTIAL PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES

*To protect and promote the health of all people in all communities*

The 10 Essential Public Health Services provide a framework for public health to protect and promote the health of all people in all communities. To achieve optimal health for all, the Essential Public Health Services actively promote policies, systems, and services that enable good health and seek to remove obstacles and systemic and structural barriers, such as poverty, racism, gender discrimination, and other forms of oppression, that have resulted in health inequities. Everyone should have a fair and just opportunity to achieve good health and well-being.

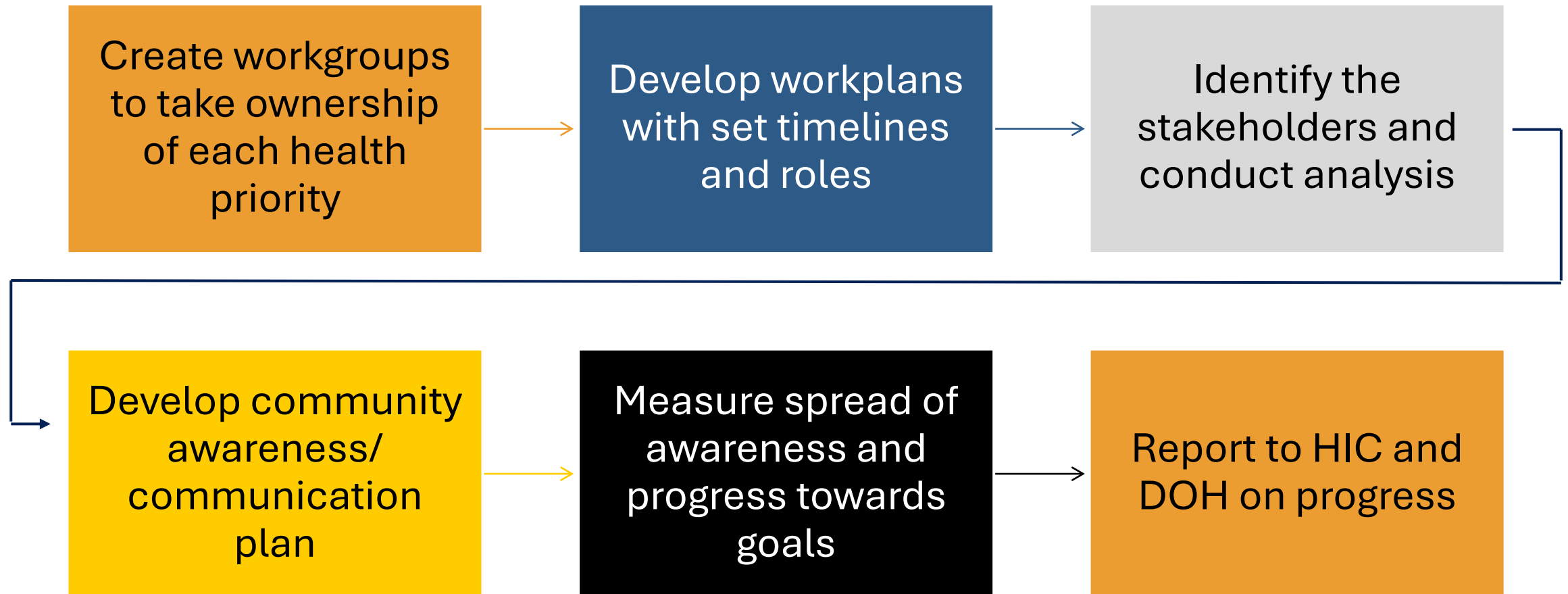

**Address factors that contribute to specific populations' higher health risks and poorer health outcomes**
  - Demonstrate how health equity is incorporated as a goal into the development of programs serving communities
  - Collaborate to address factors impacting populations with higher health risks and poorer health outcomes

# Keep in Mind

Working	Working collaboratively to develop a workplan that multiple partner will implement (PHAB measure 5.2.3 A)
Designating	Designating organizations and individuals that are responsible for implementing SHIP strategies (PHAB measure 5.2.2 S)
Identifying	Identifying implementation strategies that will be led by the health department (PHAB measure 5.2.3 A)
Linking	Linking to the health department strategic plan (PHAB measure 5.3.2 A)
Leading	Leading policy and systems approaches to address the priority strategic issues.
Tracking	Tracking progress and impact, including an annual report on progress and revisions or updates to SHIP (PHAB measures 5.2.3 A and 5.2.4 A)

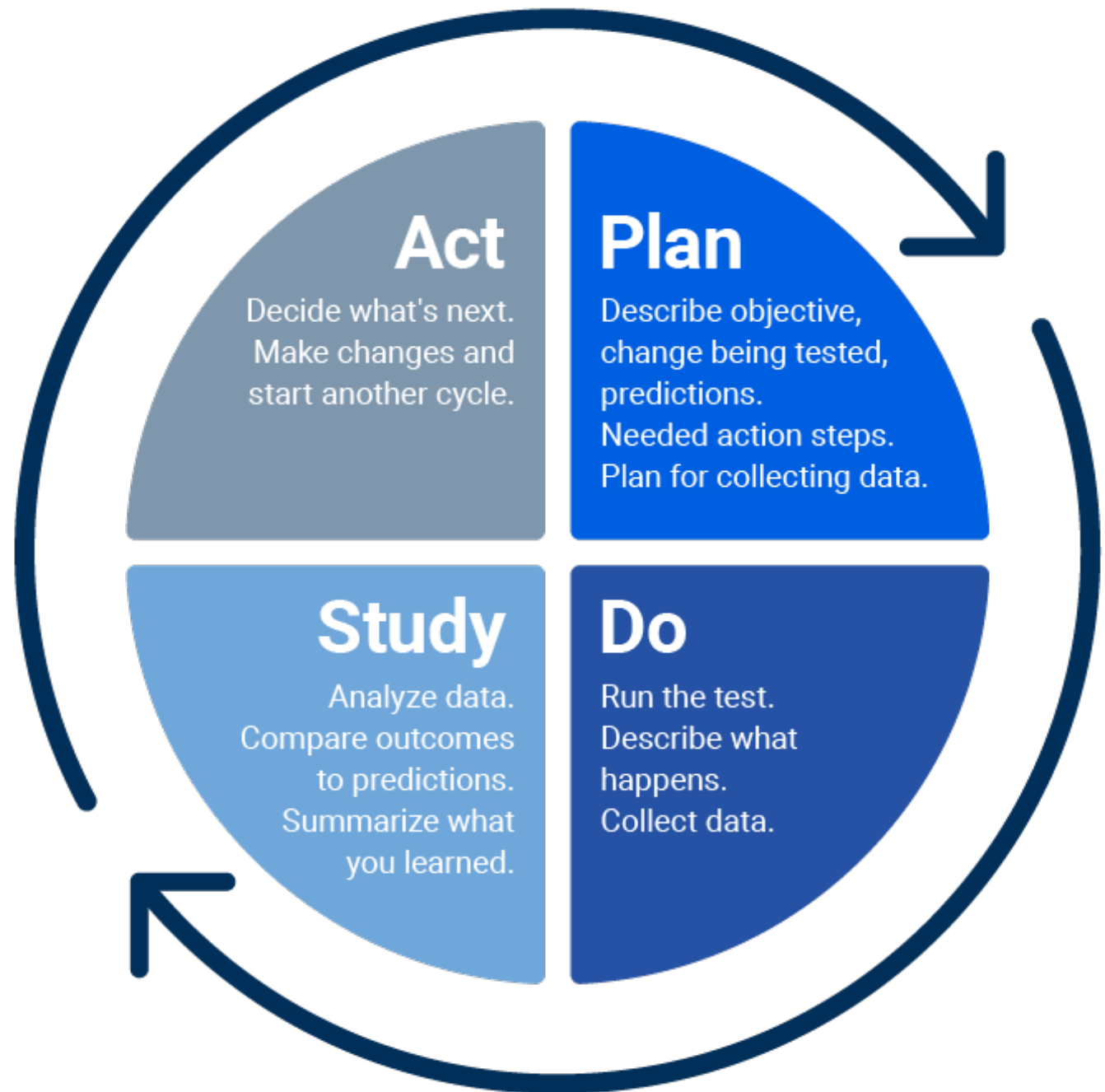
### Goal: Reduce second-hand smoke exposure

**Objective:** Increase the proportion of multi-unit housing facilities [from 1% (baseline) to 24% (target)] with voluntary smoke-free policies by June 2026.

**Strategy:** Promote adoption of voluntary smoke free policies in public housing.
